 Shelving, IT's (I asked why she did the IT's and she said because she wants to get the IT's ready for the crates, I told her to leave it and switch off the screen)

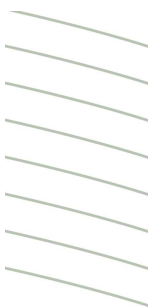
**Staff member 4:**

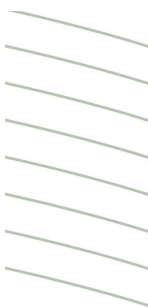

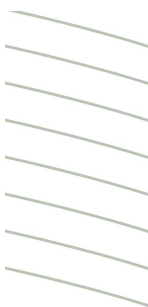
