How to make – Pleated Sculpture



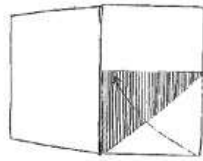
Items

- Time



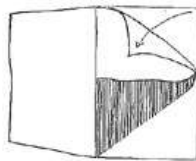

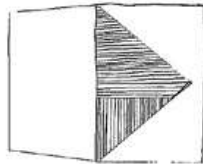
First fold

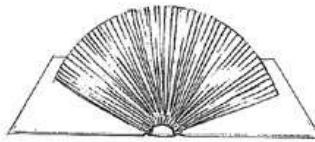
Second fold

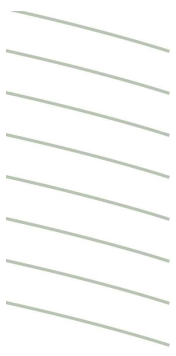


Fold all pages in book



How to make – Narrative Vase



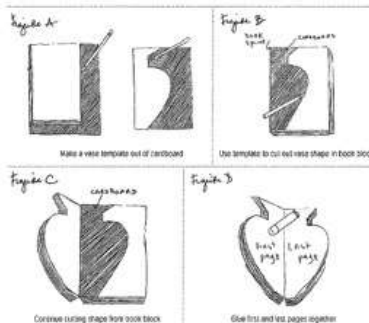
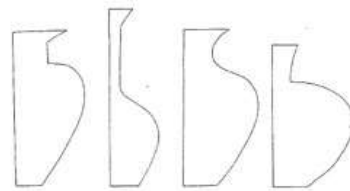
