### JOINT STATEMENT OF LC, NLM, AND NAL ON *RDA* (MAY 1, 2008)

A letter from Deanna B. Marcum (Associate Librarian for Library Services, Library of Congress) and the text of the *Joint Statement of the Library of Congress, the National Library of Medicine, and the National Agricultural Library on Resource Description and Access* have been posted on ATLANTIS and ATLATech and several other library listservs. The *Joint Statement* says the three libraries have agreed to commit to the continued development and completion of *RDA*, and to then make a decision on whether or not to implement the rules based on "the positive evaluation of *RDA*'s utility within the library and information environment, and criteria reflecting the technical, operational, and financial implications of the new code." If, after completing their research, a decision is made to implement *RDA*, that implementation will not occur before the end of 2009.
