Changes are also highlighted in gray. Numbers that appear in square brackets are not printed in the printed editions of the classification schedules. They are shown on this list only to indicate the location of the corresponding caption or reference within the classification.

RDA UPDATE

The Joint Steering Committee for Development of RDA (formerly called The Joint Steering Committee for Revision of AACR), is now projecting early 2009 as the new release date for

RDA: Resource Description and Access. Prior to that date, their calendar shows this course of events:

- December 2007-March 2008: Review of part B
- July-September 2008: Review of complete draft of RDA

The JSC Web site notes an article written by Chris Oliver called “Changing to RDA,” which is published in *Feliciter* 53, no. 5 (2007). The article describes the need for, nature of, and potential effects of the new rules.

Barbara Tillett is scheduled to give a presentation on RDA at The Greenbrier, West Virginia, during the West Virginia Library Association Conference (Dec. 3-5, 2008). There will be other presentations between now and then on RDA if you’d like to travel to Canada, Buenos Aires, or Stockholm (see details on the JSC Web site).

I’ve been working on a local Technical Services Web page for our library for a while now, adding pages as I find the need for them. It is currently only accessible on our local network, but I’ve included the content of the Cataloging Department page below so you can see what kind of ideas it might present you. If you design such a page, you will need to consider what kind of information you want on it as well as whether you want that information to be public or private (or some combination thereof). Web designers can give you advice about

how to display the data you wish to include. Personally, I don't like a page to be so "busy" that your eyes don't know where to land. FrontPage was used to create it, but you can of course use whatever software you are comfortable with. Our site isn't as fancy as the Web sites above; however, it is quite functional and very useful. The picture below is of one of several stained glass windows we have in the library reading room; it has been incorporated into the Web page along with the mouse-over text.
