CONSER STANDARD RECORD

[Comments due by May 5, 2007]

The final reports of the Access Level Record for Serials Working Group and the Working Group on Authentication Codes and Encoding Levels for Serials and Integrating Resources have been approved by PCC, and the recommendations for the CONSER standard record will be implemented in the near future. The standard record is designed to provide for quick correct identification and access to serials titles. To that end, the Working Groups have defined which elements are required and which are optional. The final version of the CONSER documentation and the new LCRI's will be available on the [CONSER home page](#) as well as the [Library of Congress Web site](#). Here is a link to the [March 29, 2007 draft](#) of the documentation in PDF. Comments on this draft are being accepted until May 5, 2007.

Comments on the CONSER documentation should be sent to Les Hawkins (lhaw@loc.gov), Diane Boehr (boehrd@mail.nlm.nih.gov), and Regina Reynolds (rrey@loc.gov). Comments on the LCRI's should be sent to cps@loc.gov. It is requested that "comments should relate to the clarity of the wording of the documents, not to decisions related to the adoption of the CONSER standard record." You might also want to take a look at the [SCCTP Presentation](#) (PowerPoint) on the standard record.

WORKING GROUP ON THE FUTURE OF BIBLIOGRAPHIC CONTROL

The Working Group on the Future of Bibliographic Control was established by the Library of Congress to investigate the future of bibliographic control in light of the challenges being presented by the digital world. It is chaired by Dr. José-Marie Griffiths, Dean of the School of Library and Information Science at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Their [web site](#) describes their mandate and activities.
