LIBRARY OF CONGRESS NEWS

In addition to the publication of the article by Karen Calhoun (recently announced on ATLATech) entitled "The Changing Nature of the Catalog and Its Integration with Other Discovery Tools" (http://www.loc.gov/catdir/calhoun-report-final.pdf), the following announcements have been posted on CPSO's Web site (http://www.loc.gov/catdir/cpso/)

A draft of the revision to LCRI 22.1B has been posted (on 4/11/06) and can be accessed via http://www.loc.gov/catdir/cpso/22_1bdft.pdf. It is intended to clarify and amplify the meaning of the AACR2 rule on persons who work both in a verbal and nonverbal context.

The document "Unicode Implementation at the Library of Congress, Cataloging Policy Position" (posted 3/21/06) was updated on March 16, 2006. It outlines the current use of non-Latin characters in bibliographic records, LC's technical capabilities in their Voyager system, and future opportunities for the expanded use of Unicode in bibliographic and authority records.
