This list consists of headings selected from the Library's lists numbers 14 to 26 of 2002.

The following conventions are used, as in previous lists:

Headings are in a single alphabetical sequence, preceded by MARC tags.
The record number (Library of Congress control number) follows the heading.
The absence of the instruction [May Subd Geog] means that the heading is **not** to be further divided by place.

The following print constants appear:

UF = Used For
BT = Broader Term
RT = Related Term
SA = See Also
* Asterisks mark lines (or paragraphs) which are CHANGES.

Selected changes to free-floating subdivisions are at the end of the list. Changes have been made to the treatment of the subdivision --**Textbooks**. The full treatment of the term Textbooks (both as lead term and as subdivision), including cancellations, is included in the main listing; for those unfamiliar with MARC authority tagging, tags 180 and 185 are for headings which represent subdivision terms, \$x and \$v respectively.

Among other changes are new chronological divisions for the first millennium under the heading **Church history**. These will be welcome, but if implemented fully will entail much retrospective change in many catalogues. Treatment of the concept **Salvation** in LCSH has been revised, with many consequential changes in cross-references. Not represented in this list is a large number of changes, implementing the new policy on the naming of battles, as mentioned in the previous Bulletin.
