**Section One: New and Changed Subject Headings
from the Library of Congress Weekly Lists**
compiled by Hal Cain

The subject headings in this list have been selected from the Library of Congress Subject Headings Weekly at: <http://lcweb.loc.gov/catdir/cpsoc/cpsoc.html#subjects> . This issue of the list consists of headings selected from the Library's lists numbers 1 to 12 – the whole of the lists issued in 2000 up to the end of March.

The Library of Congress catalog (available through the WWW at <http://catalog.loc.gov>) now offers an alternative Z39.50 search, <http://www.loc.gov/catalog/> – telnet access is no longer available. It is often useful to consult the Library's catalog when the precise meaning of a heading is not clear, or to verify subdivision practice.

The following conventions are used, as in previous lists:

- Headings are in a single alphabetical sequence, preceded by MARC tags.
- The record number (Library of Congress control number) follows the heading.
- The absence of the instruction [May Subd Geog] means that the heading is **not** to be further divided by place.

The following print constants appear:

- UF = Used For
- BT = Broader Term
- RT = Related Term
- SA = See Also

* Asterisks mark lines (or paragraphs) which are CHANGES.

This selection includes a number of headings for geographical and architectural features of the Holy Land and nearby regions. Not included are changes to a variety of musical headings, including headings (in List 1) for the organ; libraries with strong music resources should check the lists. The lists also include notices of cancellation of subject headings for a number of works of art; these headings are considered superfluous, as they exist in the Name Authority File.

Changes to **free-floating subdivisions** are at the end of the list, and this time the list is quite extensive; and subdivisions for –21st century have appeared.

LIBRARY OF CONGRESS NEWS REGARDING VOYAGER

Chad Abel-Kops (Library of Congress, Serial Record Division) sends news that the Library of Congress is planning to begin migrating from Voyager release 99 to Voyager release 2000 on February 15, 2002. During this two-week period of migration, all cataloging in Voyager and OCLC/RLIN done by LC will stop. LC will set up an interim database in order for CIP to continue its bibliographic record creation and meet publishers' deadlines. He reports that "OCLC will be available for a limited number of staff to use, but this is sketchy because (1) no work files from OCLC (e.g., CONSER for serial records) will come back to the LC database until after the implementation is complete, and (2) LC is offering comp time in January to encourage as many staff as possible NOT to be here for the implementation." When the task is complete, catalog functionality between LC and other Voyager libraries already using release 2000 will be greatly improved.
