In this group are included systematic changes to headings for **Retreats.** This term now appears to have gained a more general currency – enterprises take their staff on a retreat to help formulate a "mission statement" and to sharpen their focus – so the general term for the religious kind of retreat has now been changed to **Spiritual retreats**, and the dependent terms have changed accordingly.

A number of the entries in this list illustrate the fact in the LCSH system the subdivision – **Religious aspects** is not a free-floating subdivision, but a new heading has to be established for each case.

Scope notes for denominational group headings (such as **Presbyterian Church**) have been slightly revised.
